Information about Risk:

Rocky Mountain School of Expeditionary Learning (RMSEL) has taken reasonable steps to provide your child with a safe, educational, and enjoyable experience. We wish to remind you, however, that no activity is without risk. We do not want to frighten you or reduce your enthusiasm for this activity, but we do think it is important for you to know in advance about the plans listed above and to be informed of the inherent risks.

Outdoor Experience

Hazards can include the risks associated with separation from the group, altitude sickness, exposure to the elements, proximity to assistance, cold/hot exposure, animals, severe weather, allergies, exposure to strangers, terrain, fire, avalanche, and falling objects.

Urban Experience

Hazards can include the risks associated with: contact with strangers, separation from the group, traffic, crime, physical hazards, crowds, severe weather, fire, transportation, delays, animals, water hazards, refuse, or trash, and purchased food.

Behavior Standards Certain rules have been set for the safety and well-being of all who are involved in RMSEL programs.

Your child will be **expelled from the program and returned home at the expense of the parent/guardian** if any of the following occur:

He or she takes a drug of any kind, unless under a doctor's prescription (send a copy).

He or she takes an alcoholic beverage of any kind.

He or she is involved in sexual activities with another individual.

He or she is involved with an act of theft.

He or she is in the company of another student who violates any of these rules and fails to report it.

He or she fails to follow any other reasonable directive from an instructor.

Perception of the infraction will rest with the instructional staff and may be based upon evidence that was reported and not directly observed, or as in the case of drugs and alcohol, behavior that results from consumption.

Parents agree to pick up their children promptly at 3:00 pm.

Parents: This form must be signed and returned to school with your enrollment form for the 6th Grade Crew Camp. Your child will not be allowed to participate in this activity if this form is not returned.

Parents: I have read and understood these behavior standards. I have also read the material provided about this camp and will send my child with the proper clothing, equipment, and medication for this camp.
