

City of Chico – Sycamore Pool Water Quality Testing (2026)

Summary

This document provides weekly 2026 water quality testing results for Sycamore Pool. Measurements of E. coli values taken upstream (east) and downstream (west at dam).

Water Safety Information

All lakes, streams, and creeks may contain bacteria, including E. coli. E. coli is a naturally occurring bacteria found in the intestines of people and animals. While many strains are harmless, some can cause illness.

Water quality conditions can change quickly, so it is important to take precautions.

Healthy Water Habits

- Do not swallow water.
- Wash hands after water contact.
- Shower or towel dry after swimming.
- Do not swim if you are sick.
- Avoid swimming with open cuts or sores.
