



NOTICE OF HEARING REGARDING PROPOSED ADOPTION OF A DEVELOPER FEE STUDY AND THE INCREASE OF THE STATUTORY SCHOOL FEE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Governing Board of the Pittsburg Unified School District will hold a hearing and consider input from the public on the proposed adoption of a Developer Fee Justification Study for the District and an increase in the statutory school facility fee (“Level I Fee”) on new residential and commercial/industrial developments as approved by the State Allocation Board on January 28, 2026. The adoption of the Study and the increase of the Level I Fee are necessary to fund the construction of needed school facilities to accommodate students due to development.

The public hearing of the School District, to be held May 13, 2026 will begin at 6:30PM or as soon thereafter as practicable, at 2000 Railroad Avenue, Pittsburg, CA. Members of the public are invited to comment in writing, on or before May 13, 2026, or appear in person at the hearing.

Materials regarding the Study and the Level I Fee are on file and are available for public review at the District Office located at 2000 Railroad Avenue, Pittsburg, CA or on the Pittsburg Unified School District website.
