PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT CREDITS OPTION

In partnership with UMass Global and the Madera County Superintendent of Schools, the Added Authorizations Credential Program offers the opportunity to earn Professional Development credits for each completed course in any of the three Added Authorization Programs including:

- Early Childhood Special Education
- Orthopedic Impairment
- Traumatic Brain Injury

Each program includes 4 core courses providing the opportunity, upon completion, to earn 12 professional development credits by the end of the program along with your added authorization credential.

The Added Authorization end-of-course report card verifies course completion. Typically 3 professional development credits may be purchased for \$150*
