<b>Elementary JumpStart</b> July 26 - August 5	<b>Pre - Teach</b> of essential grade level standards for incoming grade levels; Principal invitation based on student data

# 2021 Secondary Summer School Programs

<b>Mathematics Summer Bridge (Gr. 5th - 6th)</b> July 26 - August 5	<b>Mathematics Summer Bridge</b> = a jump start program for incoming 6th graders who will preview the first few units of 6th grade math in order to build confidence in mathematics (2 - week course)
<b>Middle School STEM &amp; Humanities Summer Academy (Gr. 6th - 8th)</b> June 7 - July 9	<b>The STEM &amp; Humanities Summer Academy</b> will provide engaging learning opportunities through academic intervention, enrichment, and accelerated learning opportunities, which will support a successful transition throughout middle and high school. (Science & Math + English & History)
<b>High School Summer School (Gr. 9 - 12)</b> June 7 - July 16	<b>Designed for</b> students who have failed a course and do not meet the requirements to recover credit, have fallen behind their “graduating cohort”, and who want to take additional credit courses to make room in their future schedule
<b><u>Mathematics Summer Bridge:</u></b> Garner, White, Wood, Nimitz, Krueger, Jackson <b><u>Middle School Summer School:</u></b> Garner Middle School <b><u>High School Summer School:</u></b> LEE High School	



# 2021 Special Education Program

<b>Extended School Year Services (ESY) for Elementary and Secondary Students</b> June 7 - July 1 (Regular Session) July 12 - July 29 (Extended Session)	<b>IEP focused</b> instructional/behavioral programming focused on demonstrated or potential regression (requires ARD committee decision)
<b>Algebra I Bootcamp</b> July 12 - July 29 (in - person) July 12 - August 5 (Virtual)	<b>Targeted instruction</b> for students currently eligible for Special Education services who demonstrate skill deficits in math; not successful in Alg I during 9th grade year (in - person & Virtual)
<b>Literacy Bootcamp</b> June 7 - June 17 (Virtual)	<b>Targeted instruction</b> for students currently eligible for Special Education who demonstrate skill deficits in reading and writing; have not been successful in 9th grade English I assessment and/or course (Virtual only)
<b>Elementary:</b> Larkspur and Northern Hills <b>High School:</b> LEE High School (in person); Zoom (virtual)	



# 2021 Bilingual Summer Program

<b>PK - K Enrichment</b> June 7 - July 2	<b>Summer school</b> programs that are provided under the Texas Education Code TEC 29.060 for English Learners who will be eligible for admission to kindergarten or Grade 1 at the beginning of the next school year.
<b>Elementary, Middle, and High School Newcomer Program</b> June 7 - July 1	<b>Elementary, Middle, and Secondary</b> Newcomers programs are designed to help support recent arrivals (less than three years in the U.S.) with acclimating to their newly adopted homeland
<p><b><u>Elementary PK &amp; K Bilingual Title I &amp; Non- Title Schools:</u></b>*Colonial Hills, *El Dorado, *Harmony Hills (will host Ridgeview SS), *Jackson Keller, *Larkspur, *Oak Grove, *Olmost, *Regency Place, *Stahl, *Walzem (will host East Terrell Hills SS), *Coker, *Huebner (will host Vineyard Ranch and Stone Oak) *Redland Oaks (will host Roan Forest), *Steubing Ranch (*) indicates Dual Language summer sites</p> <p><b><u>Elementary Newcomers:</u></b>Colonial Hills Elementary</p> <p><b><u>Middle School Newcomers:</u></b>Nimitz Middle School</p> <p><b><u>High School Newcomers:</u></b>LEE High School</p>
