| <b>School Report</b>                                    | 5.1    1. <b>Principals Report:</b> Sommer Grooms discussed student enrollment and reported that enrollment remains steady at 90 students. She also discussed pre-enrollment projections for the upcoming school year.<br>In response to a question raised at the previous board meeting regarding student demographics, Sommer presented a graph showing where current students are coming from.<br>She shared a list of key accomplishments and initiatives completed during the year, including the successful 8th Grade Luncheon. Student club participation continues to increase, and the after-school art program has been highly successful.<br>Sommer reported a 97% completion rate for state testing. She noted that parent presentations regarding state testing, combined with test preparation support, appear to have contributed positively to student participation and performance. |

- 5.2 **LCAP** : Sommer Grooms provided an update on the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP). She reviewed areas of concern related to achievement gaps among socioeconomically disadvantaged students, particularly in Math and English Language Arts (ELA), where performance remains below standard. Efforts are underway to address and reduce these disparities.
- She reported improvements in chronic absenteeism, noting that several program changes have contributed to positive outcomes. These changes include individualized student orientation sessions that clearly explain program expectations and increased student participation in intervention services.
- Feedback from staff and families has been positive. Sommer discussed instructional priorities and resources designed to help parents support learning at home.
- Three key priority areas have been identified for continued improvement, including increasing participation rates. For the upcoming school year, goals include hiring a new teacher to provide Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) lessons and additional academic intervention support.
- Sommer also reviewed proposed LCAP revisions and alignment efforts. She discussed current performance metrics, standards alignment, and plans to conclude the current three-year cycle while establishing priorities for the next planning period.
