DC, Gettysburg & New York



Day 1 (DC) - June 15

Arrive in The DC area and meet your dedicated PACE Travel Tour Guide. Begin with dinner then evening touring of the Washington Monument and the stunning Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts. Check-in at Sheraton Pentagon City.

Day 2 (Arlington) - June 16

Explore Mount Vernon, the ancestral home of George Washington. Continue to Arlington National Cemetery, with an opportunity to take part in a wreath-laying ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknowns (*pending approval*). Evening monument touring of the Jefferson and MLK Memorials. Then, wrap up the day with dinner at Texas Jack's BBQ.

Day 3 (DC) - June 17

Begin with a picture stop at The White House, followed by a visit to Ford's Theatre and a tour of the U.S. Capitol Building. Spend time at the National Archives, then cap off the day with a dinner dance cruise on the Potomac aboard the Spirit of Washington.

Day 4 (DC) - June 18

Visit the WWII Memorial, explore the Smithsonian Museums, and reflect at the Holocaust Memorial Museum. After dinner at Fire Works, spend the evening touring the Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, and Korean War Memorial.

Day 5 (Gettysburg) - June 19

Check out the Spy Museum before heading to Gettysburg where civil war history comes alive through a 2-hour guided battlefield tour and time at the Museum and Cyclorama. Depart for NYC with dinner en route to the DoubleTree Newark Airport.

Day 8 (NYC) - June 22

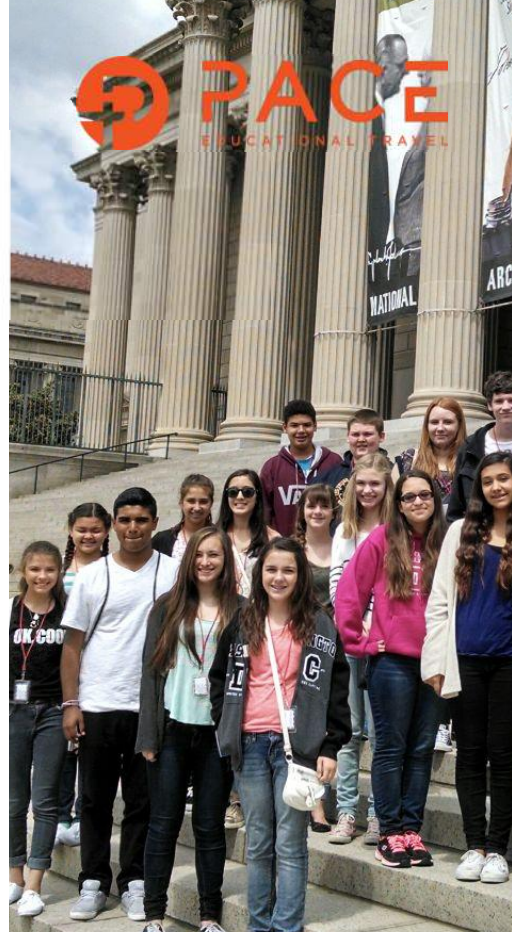
