




- Renovation of restrooms in Administration office

- Renovation of student restrooms in E-1 and E-2 buildings



















Cesar Chavez Outdoor Learning

- Redesigned safe school entrance








ECE Expansion Project

- Cameras










Cesar Chavez Carpet Replacement

Yolo County Schools Solar Resiliency & Sustainability Project


Santa Anita

HVAC Vandalism Claim Update

Background:

- September 2020: Vandalism of rooftop HVAC units at the Santa Anita administrative building.
- Initial insurance claim was approved for repair/replacement.

City of Woodland required a structural engineering assessment for permit approval.

- Assessment revealed additional structural modifications were needed before repairing/replacing HVAC units
- Northern California Relief (NCR) claims committee argued that the structural issues were pre-existing and therefore would be excluded from the claim.

HVAC Vandalism Claim Update

Actions to Date:

- Worked with insurance JPA, third-party administrator, and legal counsel to identify alternative options and remedies
- Provided additional documentation to support the need for structural repairs to be covered by the claim.
- Presented our appeal to the NCR committee in March.

Next Steps:

- NCR committee decided to keep claim open and will work with YCOE on the necessary repairs in preparation of the repairs/replacements of the vandalized HVAC units.
- Working to get quote for necessary structural repairs.
- Prepare for structural and HVAC repairs.
