



Choice Board Explanation

- Choice boards are visual tools that allow children to see what they can work towards.
- On a choice board it is important to have pictures or tiny objects that represent what the child can earn. If that option is no longer available, it is important to remove it from the choice board or cover it up to signal that it is no longer available.
- Choice Boards are often used with first/ then or with token boards so that children learn cause and effect so that they learn first what s/he must do in order to then earn the positive reinforcer.


