Hello Jackson Families! Our school year is officially underway. Students are settling in to the school day and doing a great job understanding our school routines!

We had our first fire drill on August 22nd and our students did a fantastic job following directions and practicing our safety procedures. Students also were trained in our school bus evacuation procedures. We will have fire drills every month where we will practice our evacuation procedures. We will also have a lockdown drill each trimester to practice our lockdown safety procedures in the event there is danger outside or inside the school buildings. Our goal, while practicing procedures, is to be sure all students feel safe.

As a reminder, when you arrive on campus to pick up your student at the end of the school day, it is important that you remain at the front of campus until the dismissal bell rings. If you need to come onto campus, you will need to check in at the office. If you would like to speak with a teacher after school, please reach out to the teacher in advance to set up an appointment or come to the office and we can reach out to the teacher to see if they are available. Often teachers have meetings after school so working directly with them to set up an appointment is the best practice.




