Sign up to come to the Wellness Center during homeroom to make your very own Clay Pot. This will be a two week event where you will make your clay pot this week and paint it in the future.




Friday


Rules

ANY mediums involving artistic skills are allowed. **This excludes photography or performing arts.** Acceptable forms include painting, drawing, digital art, comic art, etc.







1st wednesday is learning day, [\(slideshow tutorial\)](#) recommended for those who want to teach, or want to learn


3rd wednesday is event day (show and tell, crochet games, potential votes), recommended for those who know how to crochet, and don't want to teach, but anyone can join


