

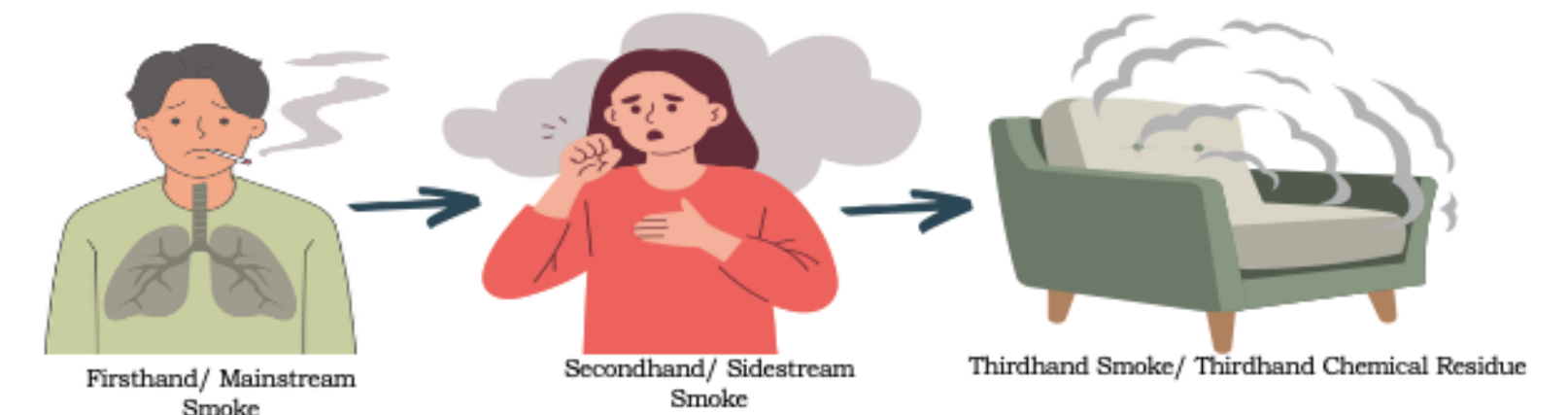
FNL vs. Thirdhand Smoke

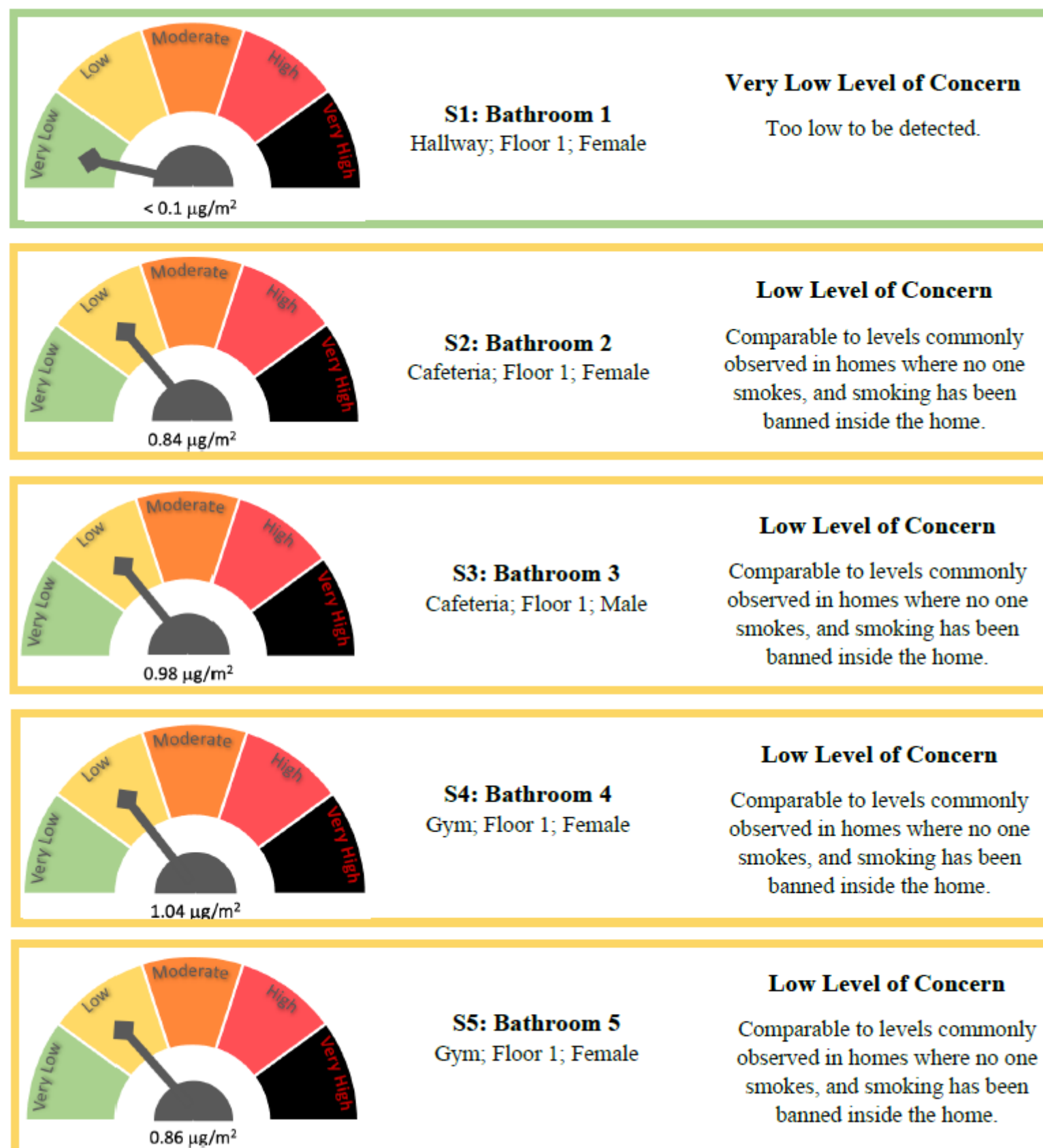
What is Thirdhand Smoke?

It's the chemical residue from tobacco smoke or aerosols:

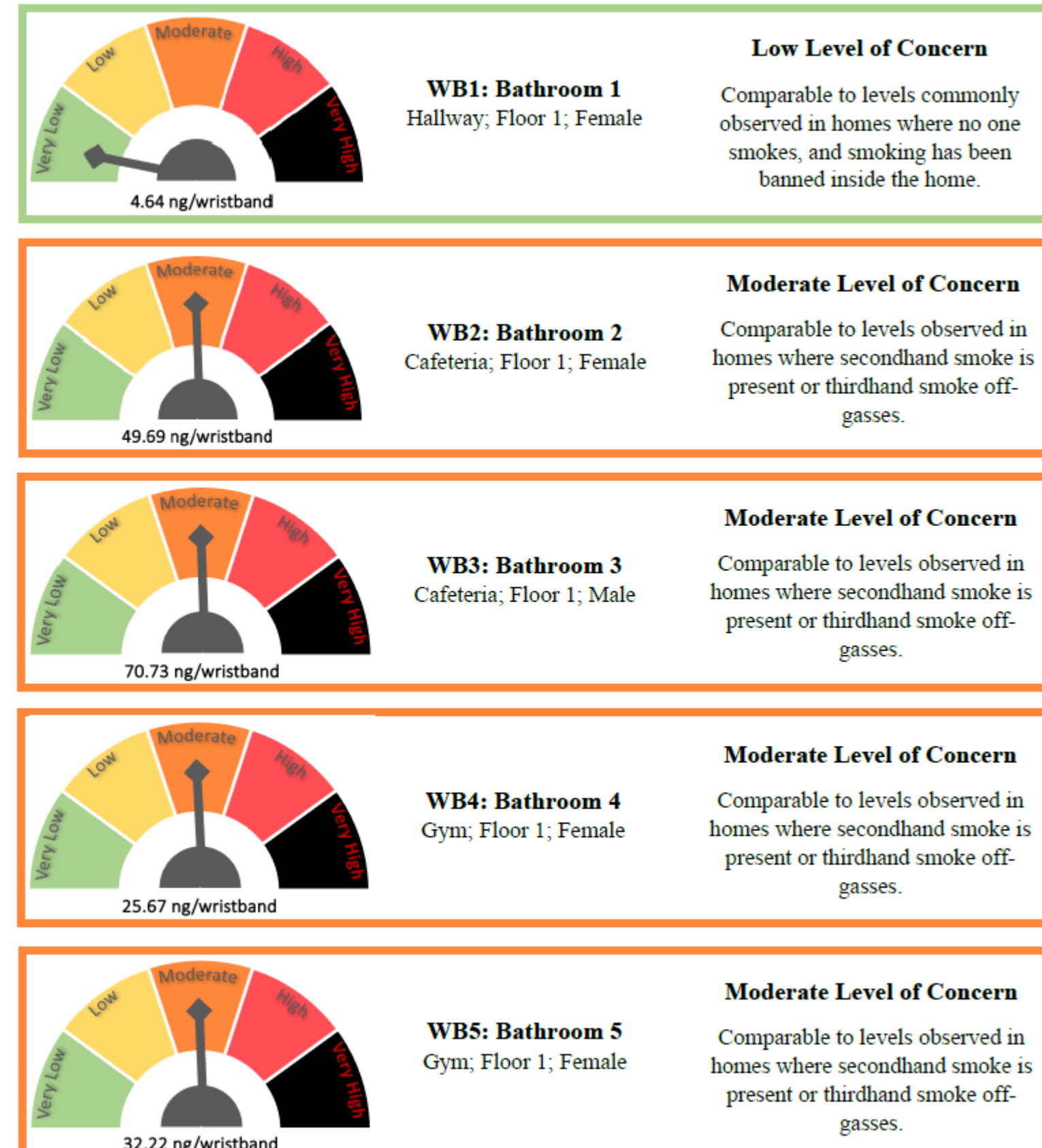
- It's unhealthy for people and pets.
- It can stick around for a long time in indoor spaces where smoking or vaping have occurred.
- It gets into your body if you inhale, swallow, or touch the chemicals.

What Does It All Mean?

- There are more than 25 chemicals found in thirdhand smoke that are known to cause **cancer** and **developmental harms**.
- Human exposure to thirdhand smoke can **damage DNA** and cause increased risk of **pulmonary disease, viral illness, and bacterial infection**.

What Can We Do?

- **Enhance cleaning protocols**
- **Support peer education to prevent tobacco use/vaping**
- **Continue to support intervention and cessations services on campus**
