- Math Curriculum Pilots for 2026-27
 - Murdock will pilot Houghton Mifflin Harcourt (HMH) Into Math for the Fall 2026 semester and for the spring 2027 semester, they will pilot the Amplify Desmos Math
 - WIS will pilot Cengage's Big Ideas California Math & You for the first six weeks of the fall semester and then Amplify Desmos Math for the last six weeks of the fall semester
- State Testing
 - MES Test Completion Status (ELA 98.30% and Math 98.86%)
 - WIS Test Completion Status (ELA 99.77%, Math 99.53%, and Science 100%)
 - WHS Test Completion Status (ELA 98.95%, Math 98.95%, and Science 100%)
 - WCHS Test Completion Status (ELA 66.67%, Math 66.67%, and Science 75%)
 - ELPAC Test Completion Status (WUSD 100%)
 - 18 WUSD students reclassified this year. We celebrated them and the seven students who received their California Seal of Biliteracy on June 1st.

State & Federal Activities |

- CALPADS Reporting–
 - We are working on the CALPADS End of Year (EOY) 1 Reporting. The last file we need to upload is the new Expanded Learning LEAP file which we can't run until July 1 as the program goes through June 30th. The due date for EOY 1 is July 17, 2026.
- Prop 28–
 - Since no changes have been made to the Prop 28 Plan approved in June 2025, which includes the 2026–27 school year, the district will not update the plan at this time. However, the district was granted a state waiver allowing the 80% allocation normally reserved for arts and music instruction to be used for arts and music supplies and materials. We sought this waiver because we were unable to hire a VAPA teacher for the 2025-26 school year. These Arts and Music in Schools (AMS) funds can be used to supplement but not supplant existing funding.
