The Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) increased 0.3 percent on a seasonally adjusted basis in September, after rising 0.4 percent in August, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported. Over the last 12 months, the all items index increased 3.0 percent before seasonal adjustment.

The index for gas rose 4.1 percent in September and was the largest factor in the all items monthly increase, as the index for energy rose 1.5 percent over the month. The food index rose 0.2 percent over the month as the food at home index increased 0.3 percent and the food away from home index increased 0.1 over the month.
