Union Mine Semester vs. Term

Term = a term refers to the length of time in the school year. Union Mine has two terms.

Term 1 = August - December
(18 weeks)

Term 2 = January - May (18 weeks)

Semester = a semester refers to the curriculum covered during the term. There are two semesters in each term earning 5 credits per class for each semester.

Term 1 (4 classes)
1st Semester = August - October
2nd Semester = October - December

Term 2 (4 new classes)
1st Semester = January - March
2nd Semester = March - May


