School Breakfast and Lunch Prices

Over the last few years, school breakfast and lunch have been provided free of charge for all students due to various federal and state programs. Unfortunately, Michigan legislators have yet to pass a school aid budget, leaving the district trying to guess what the future holds. Therefore, if the state does not include funding for free meals in its fiscal year 2026 budget package, beginning October 1, the following breakfast and lunch prices will be implemented:

Schools	Breakfast	Lunch
Elementary & Farms	\$2.50	\$3.50
Middle School	\$3.00	\$4.25
High School	\$3.50	\$4.75

These prices represent an increase of 50 cents per meal for breakfast and 75 cents per meal for lunch from the current price structure, which has been in place since the 2019-20 school year. This increase, which was recommended to and approved by the Board of Education, was necessary to cover the increased costs of the program as well as to remain within USDA guidelines for meal pricing. Why I Did Not Recommend the District Pay for Meals While We Wait for a State School Aid Budget: Facts to Consider

If the legislature does not include funding for free meals going forward, then the cost to continue providing free meals to all students would have to come from the General Fund. The Cafeteria Fund cannot use its fund balance to provide free meals to all students, as it is a violation of federal USDA regulations. For context, in the 2024-25 school year, we received approximately \$1.9M from the MI School Meals Program to provide free meals to all students. This would be a substantial cost to the General Fund if the district were to voluntarily continue the program without funding from the state. About 60% of our students participate in the MI School Meals Program.

Given the uncertainty surrounding the state budget, we believe the decision to begin charging for meals beginning October 1 (absent funding for the MI School Meals Program) and increasing the price was the best decision to remain fiscally responsible. Under law, the district was required to adopt a 2025-26 budget by June 30, even though the state has yet to adopt its 2025-26 school aid budget.
