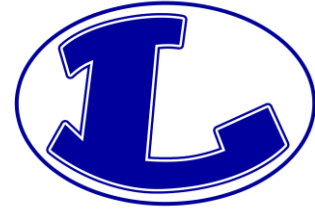

Campus Coordinated School Health Team Updates

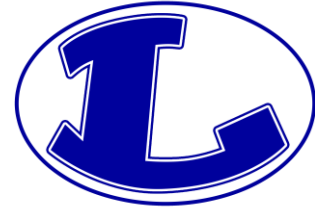
KWE: Dana Tatum

Immunizations – 3 on 30 day provisional, 1 on catch up

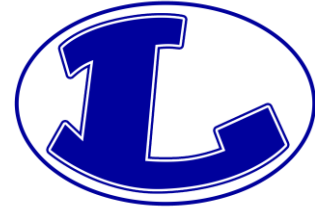
Counselor still doing Serenity Squad, meeting Tuesday and Thursday
