

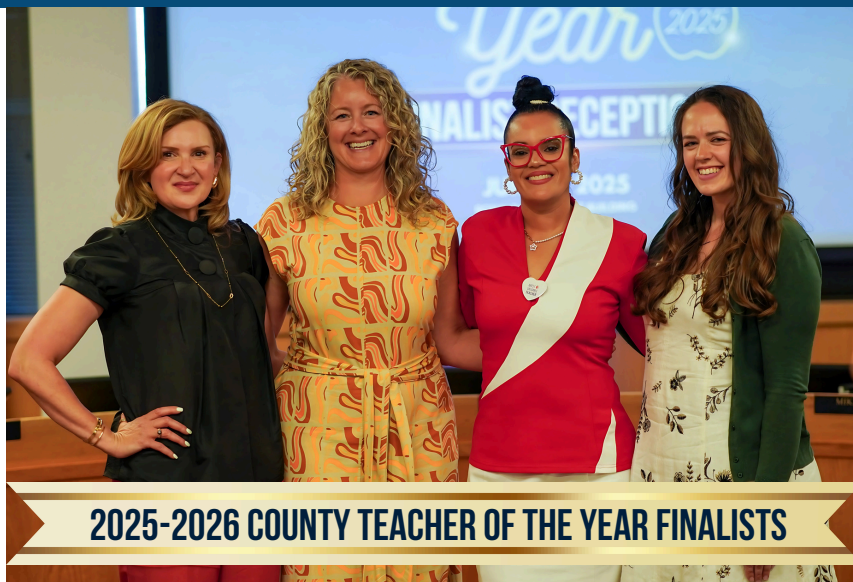
CELEBRATING TEACHING EXCELLENCE
