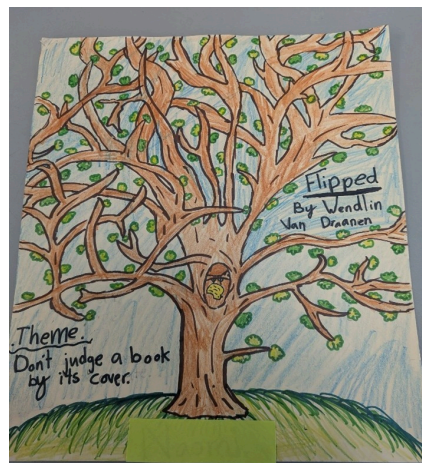

Safety Reminder -

The bike lane functions as a turn lane as you approach Holbrook Drive (once the lane line becomes a dashed line) heading West on Camino Tassajara. That is the only lane from which you can turn right onto Holbrook. Do not turn right onto Holbrook if you are not in the bike lane. Cars in the bike lane have almost been hit by cars turning from the next lane over.

PTA Bylaws

PTA Bylaw Updates:

The PTA is required to review and update its bylaws periodically to remain in compliance with governing regulations. As part of this process, we have outlined our proposed updates below for your review.

Changed our membership options from a single membership to either a single membership for \$25 (1 voting member), family membership for \$40 (two voting members), and a teacher/staff membership (1 voting member).

2. In addition to the executive vice president, there are 6 other VPs who oversee all areas of PTA: Health and Wellness, Ways and Means, Programs, Volunteers, Legislative Advocacy and Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI). This is a change from our previous 5 additional VPs.

We will be voting to adopt our new bylaws at our May 6 Association meeting at 8:05am in Room 1 — the last one of the year, so please join us!

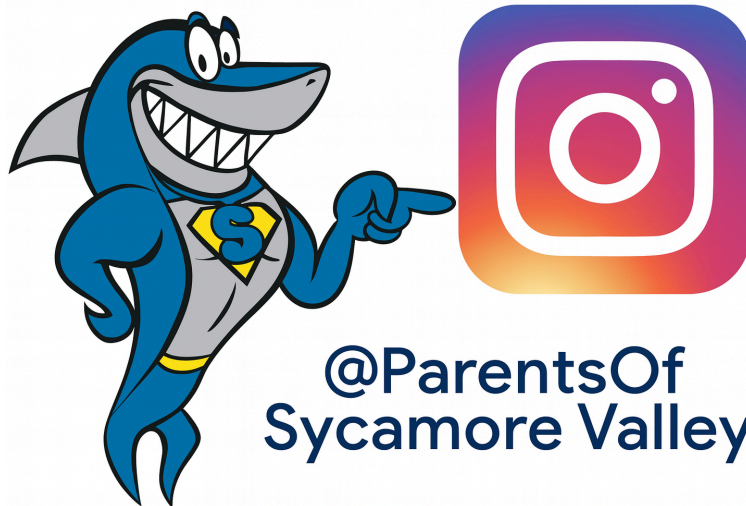
Can my child purchase a second meal?

Yes, but they need to have funds on their prepayment account, which can be done on the Titan [Family Portal](#). Cash will not be accepted in the breakfast or lunch line. Cash or checks can be given to the Child Nutrition Manager outside of the breakfast or lunch meal service time. A second breakfast is \$4.00 and a second lunch is \$5.75 at Elementary Schools and \$6.00 at Middle and High Schools. School staff can purchase a breakfast for \$4.50 and lunch for \$6.00.
