The Community Advisory Committee (CAC) acts in an advisory capacity to the Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA). The Community Advisory Committee supports individuals with exceptional needs ages 0-22 years and their families who are served by the Twin Rivers Unified School District. This committee provides an opportunity for parents, professionals and other community members to provide important input as it relates to our special education programs.

Parents comprise a majority of the membership of the Community Advisory Committee. Of these members, the majority are parents of children with special needs. Other members may include special education teachers, general education teachers, other school personnel, representatives of related public and private agencies and school administrators. Regular meetings and/or workshops ensure that members are well informed about current programs and legislation. All Community Advisory Committee meetings are open to the public.
