Message from the Principal

Dear Spartan Families,

The 2025-2026 school year is just around the corner! The staff at Red Bluff High School is excited to welcome the class of 2029 to campus! The upcoming year promises to be filled with excitement, energy, and change. It is our goal to ensure that each student feels welcomed and connected to our school community.

Teachers, administrators, and support staff are committed to creating a culture of achievement, success, and belonging for each student.
