Cell Phone Use Policy – We Need Your Support

At Maxwell Unified, we are committed to providing a safe, focused learning environment for all students. One growing challenge that impacts student learning and engagement is inappropriate cell phone use during the school day. We need your partnership in addressing this issue. At the elementary and middle school levels, students are not permitted to use cell phones at any time during the school day. Phones should remain out of sight and must not be brought to the restroom or used during breaks.

For students in grades 6–12, we have implemented a new policy to support structure and minimize distractions. All classrooms are now equipped with cell phone lock boxes, and students are required to place their phones in the designated box at the beginning of each class period.

We believe this policy will help students stay engaged, reduce distractions, and build healthier habits around technology. Summer Construction & Bond Project Updates

- New roofs have been installed at all sites

- We have entered the design phase for the elementary interior wall project and the high school gym modernization. After design completion, we must undergo a DSA approval process, which will take approximately a year before construction can begin
