Definition of Title I

- Title I is a program that provides additional academic support and learning opportunities to support students who are at risk of falling behind.
- In order to qualify for Title I schools must have at least 40% or more students who qualify for free/reduced lunch.
- Our school operates a school wide program.

Goals of Title I

- Increase academic achievement
- Provide direct instructional support to students
- Provide professional development for teachers
- Promote parent education and involvement

School Focus Goals

- Provide every student with a personalized educational plan to meet their needs.
- Provide a rigorous curriculum based on the California State Standards and Frameworks school-wide across all subject areas.
- Continue to seek reliable data to close the achievement gap by providing interventions and support to struggling students.
- Promote student achievement by continuing intervention periods to encourage self-monitoring of the Individual Growth Plan (IGP) and alternative academic settings to provide additional support for struggling students.

- The SSC develops, monitors, and evaluates the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) to implement programs and services that support students.



Family Engagement Policy & Family School Compact

School Performance Data

- Graduation rate was 91.8% - up by almost 6% from the previous year
- Increase in student reclassification utilizing ELPAC scores
- Science state test scores increased by over 22% and attendance for all tests increased
