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CITY OF CHICO'S NORTH CEDAR STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

CHICO, CA — Starting July 6, 2026, the City of Chico will begin work on the North Cedar Street Improvements Project. Mountain Cascade, Inc. will lead construction efforts that include the Full-Depth Reclamation (FDR) of North Cedar Street from West 4th Avenue south to West Sacramento Avenue. In addition, the project includes drainage improvements, the installation of curb, gutter, and sidewalk as well as landscaping improvements at the intersection of North Cedar Street and West Sacramento Avenue.

This project is funded by Local Measure H and the Regional Early Action Planning Grant (REAP 2.0) and supports Chico's goal of maintaining and modernizing public infrastructure.

Throughout the project, local access within the project construction zone will be managed with traffic controls in place to ensure safety for motorists and construction crews. Temporary delays may occur as crews and equipment maneuver through the area, with the possibility of one-lane traffic during certain phases of the project. Motorists are encouraged to plan routes accordingly, allowing for extra travel time or considering alternate paths if possible. The City of Chico appreciates the community's cooperation and patience as we work to improve our infrastructure.
