<p>A City of Chico resident with a disabled person parking placard is eligible to apply for a residential parking space if they have an automobile or live at the same address as a caregiver with an automobile.</p> <p>The resident with the disability must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Live in a single-family home with no-garage, driveway, car port, or private alley parking • Have an unexpired disability placard or tag (license plate) from the California Department of Motor Vehicles

- Written justification for requesting installation of an on-street accessible parking space in-lieu of using the driveway
- Fee payment \$32 (Special User Permit Application Processing Fee)
