1. Call to order- 3:30 pm. 2. Review of minutes from March 19, 2026- Minutes from March approved (O’Grady Motion).
3. New Business-
 - a. Approve SPSA -Charlie shared the SPSA School Plan for Student Achievement. Aligns with the LCAP and the WASC Goals. Charlie has a presentation that he shared with the team. Our “Dashboard” is in the blue and green on indicators and we were designated as a Blue Ribbon School. Three goals are the main part of the SPSA. We were shown the interface for the SPSA document. The form looks like it was made in 2001. Site Council is the education partner for the SPSA.

Goal one - Students with IEPs, ELA and Math outcome in screener data. Teachers put in data to help improve the scores of the IEP students on the screeners. That input is listed on the SPSA form. Question about the IEP scores being equal to Gen Ed student scores. Based on the WASC recommendations and the sub-scores on the identifiers.

Goal two - Overall academic performance. This is measured by the CAASPP and the ELA and MATH scores. Each department gave input on how to increase the scores and help the students

Goal three - Decrease the number of chronic absenteeism particularly for students with IEPs and Hispanic students. All of those sub groups have been trending downward. Question about the qualifier of the “chronic absenteeism.” Discussion about the funding of the school based on the attendance of students. Independent study contracts are a way for the school to get funding. Charlie wants to communicate more with the parents about the loss of funding and the impact of students missing school.

Voting - needs to be approved. Kathleen O’Grady moves, Kim Evans 2nds and all approve.
 - b. Robotics Team Recap- Great opportunity and did great this year. Won medals at the competitions this year. Showed videos from the build season. 3d printing helps make the parts that they use and we funded that for them before. They are able to use social media to promote the team. Showed the CAD process and the milling process for the metal router. Used data sets to find the correct formulas to measure air resistance and shooting while moving code. Building a turret shooter was helpful for their plan at the games. They had a lot of fun this season. Their Elementary team FLL team that they mentor won an award.
