 - Academic Eligibility:

- All student-athletes/team members must earn a GPA of 2.0 for the grading period.
- Students must have no more than 2 NM on their grade report.
- Students will be granted two weeks from the end of the grading period to pass <u>Essentials</u> or make up <u>Tests</u> from this grading period to raise their grade and meet eligibility requirements. Late homework or classwork will NOT be accepted for eligibility purposes.
- Students will become ineligible for participation on their team or in athletic contests beginning on Friday, October 24, 2025, if they have 3+ NC or a GPA below 2.0 for the grading period.
