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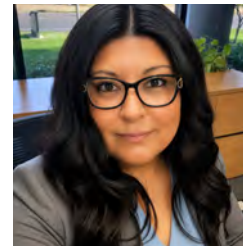

As a public servant commissioned by the Secretary of State, the Notary Public protects the integrity of legal and personal documents. ## Make Money as a Loan Signing Agent

Take your income to the next level as a Certified Loan Signing Agent. Loan Signing Agents are notaries who facilitate obtaining signatures for real estate purchases and loans, and typically make \$75-\$150 per loan signing. If you have taken the notary public course, take this course and be ready to go once you get your notary commission. Certification involves an "open book" online exam taken after the class and a background check. Associated costs for certification and supplies will be explained in the class.

## Medical Assistant

**22-week program/876 hours**

**160 hours Externship**

This program prepares students to work in the medical profession. Students will train to assist physicians by performing functions related to the clinical responsibilities of a medical office such as Phlebotomy, Pharmacology and diet. They will also learn the proper use and administration of medications, taking and documenting vital signs, cardiology including proper lead placements, professional workplace behavior, ethics and the legal aspects of healthcare and HIPAA. Students will complete their First Aid/CPR/BLS training and prepare for the NCCT Certification exam.

### Program fee: \$5,000

The fee includes all textbooks, materials, a set of scrubs, immunization, one NCCT MA Certificate exam, First Aid and BLS training and HIPAA certification.

Certified Phlebotomy Technicians collect blood and non-blood specimens from patients to be analyzed in a laboratory. Hospitals, clinics, acute care facilities, and doctor's offices are common places a phlebotomy technician may work.

## Course Descriptions

### Adult Basic Education

Focuses on essential reading, writing, and math skills for academic and workplace success. Prepares students for GED, job training, or employment through individualized instruction.

### Automotive Services

Beginning and Advanced courses offer hands-on training in automotive systems, diagnostics, and maintenance. Advanced students prepare for ASE certification, proctored and paid for during incarceration. Courses align with national CTE standards.

### Cook Assistant/Cook Training

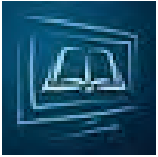
