1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Twin Rivers Unified School District hired new arts staff and increased the number of sections of the arts courses using 23-24, 24-25, and 25-26 Prop 28 funding. We were able to expand the elementary visual and performing arts program by increasing the art and music instructional minutes for all TK-6 students, and begin to offer both art and music for all 3rd graders. We were able to increase FTE by 5.25 bringing our AMS FTE to 16.05. Hiring new staff provided 13,094 TK-6 students more access to the arts. Funds were also used for maintaining our FTE for middle and high school music and arts electives, upgrading classrooms to arts spaces and storage, purchasing furniture and equipment to meet the specific needs of the arts form, providing field trip opportunities, and purchasing additional supplies and equipment including instruments. Our preschool programs implemented a districtwide music program and provided arts integration training to their staff. We also provided additional opportunities for assemblies and teaching artists to work with students at individual campuses.
