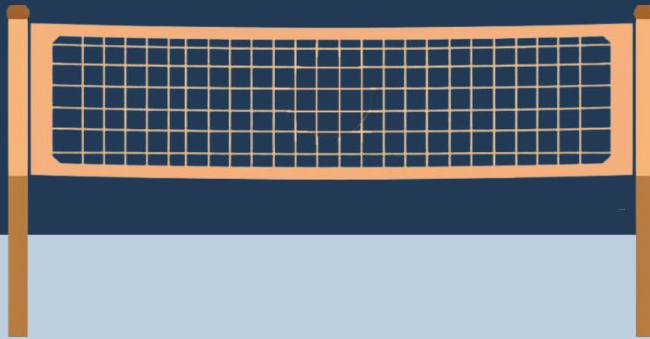

# Important Message from the Attendance Office

Are you taking an AP Exam? Do you plan to leave after the exam?

 Attendance Office volume increases exponentially during AP Testing, May 4-22.



- Request Early Release/Off Campus Requests in advance, **48 hours preferred**
