
The program clearly explained all of their safety policies and procedures regarding illness, medication and emergencies.




The program shares information on the curriculum and learning activities with me.




The program gives updates on the daily experiences of my child as appropriate (child was injured, what they ate, etc.)




The program explains my child's ongoing development to me through progress reports, parent conferences and informal conversations.




