

# *Tuilé Bag*

*(US Terms)*

**Difficulty:** Intermediate/Advanced

**Size:** *The body of the bag:* 12.5"/32 cm wide  
15"/38 cm tall  
*Handles:* 20.5"/52 cm long  
1,25"/3.25 cm wide

**Materials needed:**

- 4.5 mm (7) Hook
- *Color 1:* 71 yards / 65.1 meters (42 grams)  
and  
*Color 2:* 152 yards / 140 meters (90 grams)  
*Color 3:* 152 yards / 140 meters (90 grams) of worsted/aran weight 100% cotton yarn  
*{I used Paintbox Yarns Recycled Cotton Worsted in Meadow Green (Color 1), Peachy (Color 2)  
and Sea Green (Color 3)}*  
or alternatively you can use any other aran/worsted 100% cotton yarn
- Yarn needle for weaving in ends
- Scissors
- Stitch markers

**Stitches used and Abbreviations:**

CH = chain

ST/STS = stitch/stitches

SM = stitch marker

SP = space

SK = skip

SLST = slip stitch

SC = single crochet

HDC = half double crochet

HDC3LO = half double crochet 3<sup>rd</sup> loop only

DC = double crochet

Puff ST = puffstitch

Puff2tog = puff sttich 2 together

{ } = indicates how many stitches go into the same stitch or used to repeat a small set of instructions between these brackets the number of times given

[ ] = used to repeat a medium length set of instructions between these brackets, the number of times given

### Additional terms/ Special Stitches:

#### **Stitches in the HDC 3<sup>rd</sup> loop only (HDC3LO):**

Look at the top of the stitch and locate the sideways "V", bend the stitch to look at the back and you should see another "V". You will be working into the back loop of that "V". This creates a nice, braided look.

#### **Puff Stitch (Puff ST):**

1. Yarn over hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, pull up a long loop through that stitch (*3 loops on hook*)
2. Yarn over hook again, insert hook into the same stitch, pull up a loop (*same height as the previous one*) twice more. You should have 7 loops on your hook. (*Picture 1.*)
3. Yarn over and pull through 6 loops, (*2 loops remain on your hook*) (*Picture 2.*)
4. Yarn over and pull through both remaining loops. (*Picture 3-4.*)

*(This way, you will only have 1 loop on top of the puff stitches, instead of 2)*

*(Note: The pictures below are just demonstrating how to do the stitch and it's not from this pattern)*

### **Puff Stitch 2 together (Puff2tog):**

1. Yarn over hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, pull up a long loop through that stitch *(3 loops on hook)*
2. Yarn over hook again, insert hook into the same stitch, pull up a loop *(same height as the previous one)* twice more *(7 loops on hook)* (Picture 1.)
3. Skip 2 stitches
4. Yarn over hook, insert hook in next stitch, pull up a long loop *(9 loops on hook)*
5. Yarn over hook again, insert hook into the same stitch, pull up a loop *(same height as the previous one)* twice more. You should have 13 loops on your hook. (Picture 2.)
6. Yarn over and pull through 12 loops, *(2 loops remain on your hook)* (Picture 3-4.)
7. Yarn over and pull through both remaining loops. (Picture 5.)

**Gauge:** 4 SC and 4 Rows = 1" (2.5 cm)

**Additional notes:**

- If a round starts with a chain 1 or chain 2, that's not counted as a stitch, unless stated otherwise.
- Slip stitches do not count as stitches.
- **US terms** used throughout
- At the end of every round, there's going to be a note with the stitch count, so you can keep track of your work easily and avoid any mistakes. It's written in a different color, in **bold**.
- *Notes are written in a different color in (brackets) to help you through the pattern.*
- *You can start each round as I did in the pattern or you can use a standing stitch or chains, it's totally up to you!*

## **Instructions**

**To start:** *With Color 1 (Meadow Green)* CH 32

**Round 1:** 1 SC in the 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from the hook, 1 SC in next 29 chains, 3 SC in next CH, 1 SC on the other side in the next 29 chains, 2 SC in the last CH (*this has the 1<sup>st</sup> SC already*), join with a SLST to first SC  
**(64 SC)**

**Round 2:** CH 1, 2 SC in same ST, 1 SC in next 29 STS, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next ST, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next 29 STS, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next ST, 1 SC in the first ST with the first 2 SC in it, join with a SLST to first SC  
**(72 SC)**

**Round 3:** CH 1, 2 SC in same ST, 1 SC in next 31 STS, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next 3 STS, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next 31 STS, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next 3 STS, 1 SC in the first ST with the first 2 SC in it, join with a SLST to first SC  
**(80 SC)**

**Round 4:** CH 1, 2 SC in same ST, 1 SC in next 33 STS, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next 5 STS, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next 33 STS, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next 5 STS, 1 SC in the first ST with the first 2 SC in it, join with a SLST to first SC  
**(88 SC)**

**Round 5:** CH 1, 2 SC in same ST, 1 SC in next 35 STS, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next 7 STS, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next 35 STS, 3 SC in next ST, 1 SC in next 7 STS, 1 SC in the first ST with the first 2 SC in it, join with a SLST to first SC  
**(96 SC)**

**Round 6:** CH 1, 1 HDC in same ST (*put a SM in the 3<sup>d</sup> loop of this ST*), 1 HDC in each ST around, join with a SLST to first HDC  
**(96 HDC)**

**Round 7:** CH 1, 1 HDC3LO in same ST, 1 HDC3LO in each ST around, join with a SLST to first HDC  
(96 HDC3LO)

**Round 8:** CH 1, 1 HDC in same ST, 1 HDC in each ST around, join with a SLST to first HDC  
(96 HDC)

**Round 9:** Same as Round 8 (*note: put a SM in the first ST of the round*)  
Fasten off.  
(96 HDC)

**Round 10:** Join Color 2 (Peachy) to the first ST of last round (marked with a SM)  
CH 2 (*does not count as ST throughout*), 1 DC in same ST, 1 DC in each ST around, join with a SLST to first DC  
(96 DC)

**Round 11:** CH 1, Puff2tog by putting the first Puff ST in the same ST, SK 2 STS, put the second Puff ST in the next ST (*that's the 3<sup>rd</sup> ST from your first Puff, see the pictures1-10. below*)), CH 3, [Puff2tog by placing the next Puff ST in the next ST, SK 2 STS, put the second Puff ST in the next ST, CH 3] 23 times, join with a SLST to first Puff2tog  
(24 x Puff2tog, 24 x CH 3 SP)

**Round 12:** SLST to the SP above the Puff STS (*Picture 1.*)

CH 1, {Puff ST, CH 2, Puff ST} in same SP (*Picture 2.*), SK next CH 3 SP, [{Puff ST, CH 2, Puff ST} in SP above next Puff2tog (*Picture 3.*), SK next CH 3 SP] 23 times, join with a SLST to first Puff ST

**(24 x CH 2 SP, 48 Puff ST)**

**Round 13:** CH 2, 1 DC in same ST (*Puff ST*) (*note: put a SM in the first ST of this round*), 2 DC in next CH 2 SP between Puffs, 1 DC in next ST (*Puff ST*), [1 DC in next ST (*Puff ST*), 2 DC in next CH 2 SP between Puffs, 1 DC in next ST (*Puff ST*)] 23 times, join with a SLST to first DC  
**Fasten off.**

(96 DC)

**Round 14:** *Join Color 3 (Sea Green) to the first ST of last round (marked with a SM)*  
CH 2, 1 DC in same ST, 1 DC in each ST around, join with a SLST to first DC

(96 DC)

**Round 15:** CH 1, 1 DC in same ST, 1 DC in next ST, CH 2, SK 2 STS, [1 DC in next 2 STS, CH 2, SK 2 STS] 23 times, join with a SLST to first DC

(24 x CH 2 SP, 48 DC)

**Round 16:** CH 2, 1 DC in same ST, 1 DC in next ST (*note: put a SM in this ST*), 2 DC in next CH 2 SP, [1 DC in next 2 STS, 2 DC in next CH 2 SP] 23 times, join with a SLST to first DC  
**Fasten off.**

(96 DC)

**Round 17:** *Join Color 2 (Peachy) to the 2<sup>nd</sup> ST of last round (marked with a SM)*  
then work as Round 14

(96 DC)

**Round 18:** Same as Round 15

(24 x CH 2 SP, 48 DC)



**Round 19:** Same as Round 16 (*note: put a SM into the 3<sup>rd</sup> ST of this round*)

**Fasten off.**

(96 DC)

**Round 20:** *Join Color 3 (Sea Green) to the 3<sup>rd</sup> ST of last round (marked with a SM)*  
then work as Round 10

(96 DC)

**Round 21:** Same as Round 11

(24 x Puff2tog, 24 x CH 3 SP)

**Round 22:** Same as Round 12

(24 x CH 2 SP, 48 Puff ST)

**Round 23:** Same as Round 13 (*note: put a SM into the 2<sup>nd</sup> ST of this round*)

**Fasten off.**

(96 DC)

**Round 24:** *Join Color 1 (Meadow Green) to the 2<sup>nd</sup> ST of last round (marked with a SM)*  
CH 1, 1 SC in same ST, 1 SC in each ST around, join with a SLST to first SC

(96 SC)

**Round 25:** CH 1, 1 SC in same ST (*note: put a SM into this ST*), 1 SC in each ST around, join with a SLST  
to first SC

**Fasten off.**

(96 SC)

**Round 26:** *Join Color 2 (Peachy) to the 1<sup>st</sup> ST of last round (marked with a SM)*  
then work as Round 14

(96 DC)

**Round 27:** Same as Round 15

(24 x CH 2 SP, 48 DC)

**Round 28:** Same as Round 16 (*note: put a SM into the 2<sup>nd</sup> ST of this round*)

**Fasten off.**

(96 DC)

**Round 29:** *Join Color 3 (Sea Green) to the 2<sup>nd</sup> ST of last round (marked with a SM)*  
then work as Round 14

(96 DC)

**Round 30:** Same as Round 15

(24 x CH 2 SP, 48 DC)

**Round 31:** Same as Round 16 (*note: put a SM into the 2<sup>nd</sup> ST of this round*)

**Fasten off.**

(96 DC)



**Round 32:** *Join Color 2 (Peachy) to the 2<sup>nd</sup> ST of last round (marked with a SM)*  
then work as Round 10

(96 DC)

**Round 33:** Same as Round 11

(24 x Puff2tog, 24 x CH 3 SP)

**Round 34:** Same as Round 12

(24 x CH 2 SP, 48 Puff ST)

**Round 35:** Same as Round 13 (*note: put a SM into the 2<sup>nd</sup> ST of this round*)  
**Fasten off.**

(96 DC)

**Round 36:** *Join Color 3 (Sea Green) to the 2<sup>nd</sup> ST of last round (marked with a SM)*  
CH 1, 1 SC in same ST, 1 SC in each ST around, join with a SLST to first SC

(96 SC)

**Round 37:** CH 1, 1 SC in same ST, 1 SC in next 13 STS, CH 70, SK 20 STS, 1 SC in next 28 STS, CH 70, SK 20 STS, 1 SC in next 14 STS, join with a SLST to first SC

(56 SC, 140 CH)

**Round 38:** CH 1, 1 HDC in same ST, 1 HDC in next 13 STS, 1 HDC in next 70 CH, 1 HDC in next 28 STS, 1 HDC in next 70 CH, 1 HDC in next 14 STS, join with a SLST to first HDC

(196 HDC)

**Round 39:** CH 1, 1 HDC in same ST, 1 HDC in each ST around, join with a SLST to first HDC

(196 HDC)

**Round 40:** CH 1, 1 SC in same ST (*note: put a SM in this ST*), 1 SC in each ST around, join with a SLST to first SC  
**Fasten off.**

(196 SC)

**Round 41:** *Join Color 1 (Meadow Green) to the 1<sup>st</sup> ST of last round (marked with a SM)*  
then work as Round 40

(196 SC)

**Fasten off, weave in all ends.**
