## **BOARD OF TRUSTEES REPORTS:**

### **3. LCAP**

Ms. Cain reported that the new plan is now open and she has begun working on it, comparing with our current one on what we have spent and where. She noted that Goal 4 is going away so some items will be moving to other goals. She also shared a spreadsheet showing all the funds that have expiring dates to spend.

### **4. Public Hearing Developer Fees**

The hearing opened at 4:23 pm. Ms. Cain reviewed the updated fee amounts and explained the process for property owners that build in McCloud. She reported that our school receives 60% of the funds collected and Siskiyou Union High School District the other 40%. The hearing closed at 4:29 with no public comments.

### **5. Adoption of Revised Developer Fees**

Mr. Bringle made a motion to approve the adoption of Revised Developer Fees as presented. The motion was seconded by Stewart and passed by the board.

### **6. 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Trip Itinerary**

Ms. Cain presented the itinerary of the 8<sup>th</sup> grade trip from May 22<sup>nd</sup> -24<sup>th</sup>. They will stay in an Air B&B in either Santa Clara/San Jose/Milpitas, visit Winchester Mystery House, Egyptian Museum, the Great Mall in Milpitas and Great America. She thanked the SVRC for their generous donation of \$2,584 which will go into the 8<sup>th</sup> grade fund, not to individual students. Mrs. Jones made a motion to approve the itinerary as presented. The motion was seconded by Ms. Stewart and passed by the board.

### **6. Williams Quarterly Report**

Ms. Cain reported that there weren't any complaints received for the quarter.

### **7. Listed Bills**

Mr. Bringle made a motion to approve the listed bills. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Mero and pass by the board.

Ms. Stewart reported that today is the opening day for Bogey's Café which is under new ownership.

Ms. Mero reminded the board that the McCloud Resource Center is hosting a Jr. High Tea on May 17<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 pm for students and their parents. She said the Resource Center will have a kids' week after summer school ends. She also reported that the coat distribution will be different next year. They will be doing a coat exchange instead.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:**

\*Ms. Cain expressed gratitude to the Board for her hot spot. She said she is doing more work at home and having access has been wonderful.

\*Ms. Cain shared that Louie Mero has been busy working on a checklist of items for the school. He has replaced the computer room door, lubed and adjusted all school doors so that they open and close with ease. He rebuilt the fence around the garbage dumpsters and the outside drinking fountain.

\*Ms. Cain updated the Board about the new school van. We should have it by mid-June and the company will bill us as soon as it is done in production.

\*Ms. Cain has advertised for an instructional aide and found out today that EDJOIN has not been notifying her when someone applies. She has received 6-7 applications since January that she did not know about. She will begin looking at them and start a review process.
