Reminder About Kindergarten Orientation

Hartland Consolidated Schools 2026-27 Kindergarten orientation will be held on Saturday, January 31, 2026 from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at the Hartland Educational Support Service Center, 9525 E. Highland Rd. The orientation will provide parents an opportunity to hear from kindergarten teachers about a “typical” school day and the kindergarten curriculum.

In addition, administrators will be on hand to talk about school safety, bus transportation, school attendance areas, student nutrition, Junior Kindergarten, and answer any questions. Parents may begin the online pre-enrollment process beginning February 1st at www.hartlandschools.us/enrollment. The following documents are required and may be uploaded as part of the online process:

- Birth Certificate
- Immunization Records- with proof of DTP, Polio, MMR, Hepatitis B, Chicken Pox vaccines (or proof of having illness)
- Vision screen and dental screen
- Proof of Residency- examples include: certificate of occupancy, purchase agreement, builder’s permit, rent receipt or agreement, mortgage statement/receipt, voter registration card, utility bill, driver’s license.

Children are eligible to enroll in kindergarten if they will have their fifth (5th) birthday on or before September 1, 2026. A child who turns five after September 1st and before December 1, 2026 may enroll if parent/legal guardian signs a waiver that is supported by the school district (waiver is included in the online pre-enrollment documents). A full-day Junior Kindergarten program may be offered. A minimum number of students are required for the program to be made available. Parents may need to provide transportation in order to participate. The age requirement for Junior Kindergarten is the same as the traditional Kindergarten program.
