

- MFA: Secure data and log-ins with multifactor authentication an authenticator app is the safest option. (Google Authenticator or Microsoft Authenticator) Update two-step verification here: https://mysignins.microsoft.com/security-info
- 2. Passwords: Use strong passwords 12 to 15 characters are recommended. Update staff or student passwords here: https://password.srvusd.net/
- 3. Phishing: Identify and report phishing
- 4. Software Updates: Be sure to update devices to the latest version to avoid vulnerabilities.
- For families: <u>Digital Safety Family Check Up</u>
- For teens: Think Before You Tap


Here is the link to sign up. **Be A Mentor** Click on the New Volunteers Apply Now on the bottom right side of the page.







Science Olympiad Information Nights

Is your student a 4th or 5th grader interested in science? Would they like to gain some handson experience and deepen their knowledge of STEM? Can my child purchase a second meal?

Yes, but they need to have funds on their prepayment account, which can be done on the Titan Family Portal. Cash will not be accepted in the breakfast or lunch line. Cash or checks can be given to the Child Nutrition Manager outside of the breakfast or lunch meal service time. A second breakfast is \$4.00 and a second lunch is \$5.75 at Elementary Schools and \$6.00 at Middle and High Schools. School staff can purchase a breakfast for \$4.50 and lunch for \$6.00.
