5.7 CBO Report: Ms. Boone shared that the 26/27 State budget was recently released by Governor Newsom. She noted that this begins the budget cycle for next school year.

It was reported that since the last board meeting the District has been awarded over \$800,000 in new grants including SWP grants for CTE programs and a bridge grant to support the district's CYBHI implementation.

The second interim budget will be brought for review and approval at the March Board meeting.

6. FACILITIES:

6.1 Facilities Report: Superintendent Perry provided an update on the TK classroom project at Mill Street. He announced the planned occupancy date for the four new classrooms is February 23, 2026. Professional movers will assist staff with the move. The ribbon cutting ceremony on February 13, 2026. It was noted that the partnership with Core construction and VPCS has contributed greatly to the successful project.

Superintendent Perry also discussed Milestone 3, the addition of a second ELOP building at Fairview Elementary.

In the coming months he will bring forward more information regarding a possible new gym project for Orland High School.
