FINISHED SIZES

Instructions given fit size small; changes for medium, large, X-large, 2X-large and 3X-large are in [].

FINISHED MEASUREMENT

Bust: 36 inches (*small*) [39 inches (*medium*), 42 inches (*large*), 45 inches (*X-large*), 48 inches (*2X-large*), 51 inches (*3X-large*)].

Fit is close-fitting with 2 inches of ease.

MATERIALS

- Universal Yarn Nazli Gelin Garden 5 Egyptian crochet cotton (174 yds/50g per ball):
 - 4 [5, 5, 6, 6, 7] balls #74 steel grey
 - 1 [1, 1, 2, 2, 2] ball(s) #69 light tan
- Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Blocking pins
- Water spray bottle

GAUGE

In alternating rows of tr and sc: 21 sts = 4 inches; 12 rows = 4 inches



PATTERN NOTES

Chain-4 at beginning of row counts as first treble crochet unless otherwise stated.

Chain-6 at beginning of row counts as first treble crochet and chain-2 unless otherwise stated.

Chain-7 at beginning of row counts as first treble crochet and chain-3 unless otherwise stated.

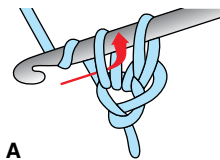
Chain-11 at beginning of row counts as first **triple treble crochet** (see *Stitch Guide*) and chain-4 unless otherwise stated.

Chain-5 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet and chain-2 unless otherwise stated.

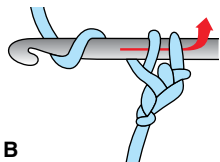
Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

SPECIAL STITCHES

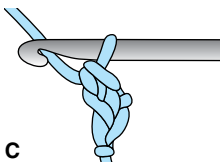
First foundation single crochet (first foundation sc): Ch 2, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, pull up 1p (see *illustration*), yo, pull through 1 lp on hook (*ch-1 made*), yo, pull through all lps on hook (*sc made*).

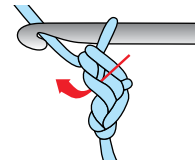

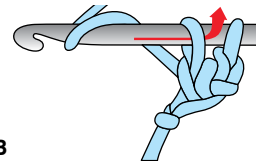

First Foundation Single Crochet

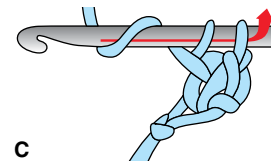
Next foundation single crochet (next foundation sc): Insert hook in last ch-1 made (see *illustration*), pull up 1p, yo, pull through 1 lp on hook (*ch-1*), yo, pull through all lps on hook (*sc*).



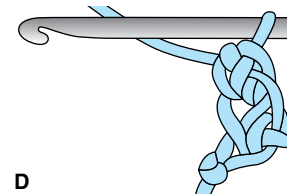

Next Foundation Single Crochet

TEE Panel

Make 1 for Front & 1 for Back.

Foundation row: With gray, work **first foundation sc** (see *Special Stitches*), work 93 [101, 109, 117, 125, 133] **next foundation sc** (see *Special Stitches*), turn.

Row 1: Ch 4 (see *Pattern Notes*), tr in each sc across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each tr across, ending with sc in top of turning ch, turn.

Next rows: [Rep rows 1 and 2 alternately] 18 [18, 18, 20, 20, 20] times, rep row 1 once for total of 40 [40, 40, 44, 44, 44] rows, including foundation row.

Raglan Shaping

Row 1: Sl st in each of first 11 [15, 19, 16, 20, 24] tr, sc in each tr across, leaving last 11 [15, 19, 16, 20, 24] tr unworked, turn. (72 [72, 72, 86, 86, 86] sc)

Row 2: Ch 3 (*does not count as first st*), tr in each sc across to last 2 sc, **tr dec** (*see Stitch Guide*) in last 2 sc, turn. (70 [70, 70, 84, 84, 84] tr)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each tr across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3 (*does not count as first st*), tr dec in next 2 sc, tr in each sc to last 3 sc, tr dec in last 3 sc, turn. (66 [66, 66, 80, 80, 80] tr)

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each tr across, turn.

Sizes Small, Medium & Large Only

Next rows: [Rep rows 2–5 consecutively] twice, [rep rows 2 and 3] once. At end of last row, fasten off. (52 [52, 52] sc at end of last row)

Sizes X-Large, 2X-Large & 3X-Large Only

Next rows: *[Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately] twice, [rep rows 4 and 5] once, rep from * once, [Rep rows 2 and 3] once. At end of last row, fasten off. ([62, 62, 62] sc at end of last row)

Sleeve

Make 2.

Row 1: With tan, ch 45, dc in 5th ch from hook (*first 4 chs count as first dc and ch-1*), [ch 3, sk next 4 chs, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch, ch 3, sk next 4 chs, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch] across to end, turn. (4 st reps)

Row 2: Ch 6 (*see Pattern Notes*), (sc, {ch 4, sc} twice) in next ch-1 sp, [ch 3, sk ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp] across to last 3 ch-4 sps, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, (sc, {ch 4, sc} twice, ch 2, tr) in last turning ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 4 (*counts as dc and ch-1*), [(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp] across to last ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in last ch-4 sp, ch 1, dc in turning ch, turn.

Row 4: Ch 7 (*see Pattern Notes*), sk next ch-1 sp, [(sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) 3 times in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3] across to last ch-1 sp, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr in turning ch, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first tr, *ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across to last 3 ch-4 sps, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, sc in 4th ch of turning ch, turn.

Row 6: Ch 11 (*see Pattern Notes*), [(sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3] across to last ch-1 sp, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 4, trtr in last sc, turn.

Row 7: Ch 6, (sc, ch 4, sc) in trtr, [ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp] across to last 3 ch-4 sps, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, (sc, ch 4, sc, ch 2, tr) in 7th ch of turning ch, turn. (5 st reps)

Row 8: Ch 3 (*counts as dc*), (dc, ch 1, dc) in ch-2 sp, [ch 3, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp] across to last ch-1 sp, ch 3, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in turning ch sp, turn.

Row 9: Ch 5 (*see Pattern Notes*), [(sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3] across to last ch-1 sp, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 2, dc in top of turning ch, turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in first dc, ch 2, [sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3] across to last 3 ch-4 sps, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 2, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn.

Row 11: Ch 7, [(sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3] across to last ch-1 sp, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr in last sc, turn.

Row 12: Ch 5, (sc, ch 4, sc) in next tr, [ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp]* across to last 3 ch-4 sps, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, (sc, ch 4, sc, ch 2, dc) in turning ch sp, turn. (6 st reps)

Sizes Small, Medium & Large Only

At end of last row, fasten off.

Sizes X-Large, 2X-Large & 3X-Large

Row [13]: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch-1), dc in dc, [ch 3, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-4 sp] across to last ch-1 sp, ch 3, (sc, {ch 4, sc} 3 times) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in turning ch sp, turn.

Rows [14–16]: Rep rows 2–4, At end of last row, fasten off.

Finishing

Lay Panels out to schematic size. Pin in place. Spray with water to block and allow to dry. Pin front and back Panels tog with RS facing.

Sew side of Panels tog, turn inside out.

Bottom Edging

Join (see Pattern Notes) gray to bottom edge, sc evenly around bottom edge, join to first sc. Fasten off.

Armhole Edging

Join gray to underarm area, ch 1, [sc across underarm, sc up raglan edge, 2 sc in corner, sc across collar, 2 sc in corner, sc down raglan edge] across body. Fasten off.

Sleeve Edging

Join tan to raglan edge of Sleeve, sc up raglan edge evenly, 2 sc in corner, sc across collar edge, 2 sc in corner, sc down raglan edge evenly. Fasten off.

Raglan Seam

Pin Sleeve to body at raglan seam with WS facing. Align front raglan, underarm, and back raglan. Join gray to right side of raglan seam, sl st in each sc across each raglan edge. Fasten off.

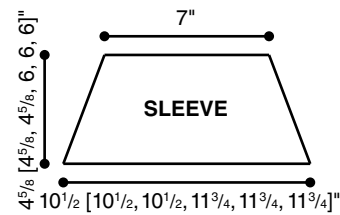
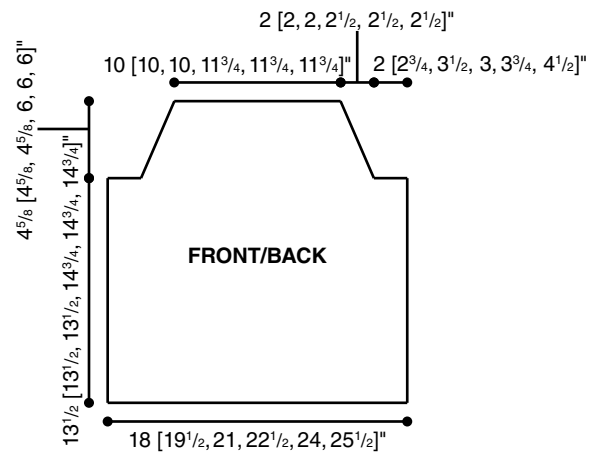
Collar Edging

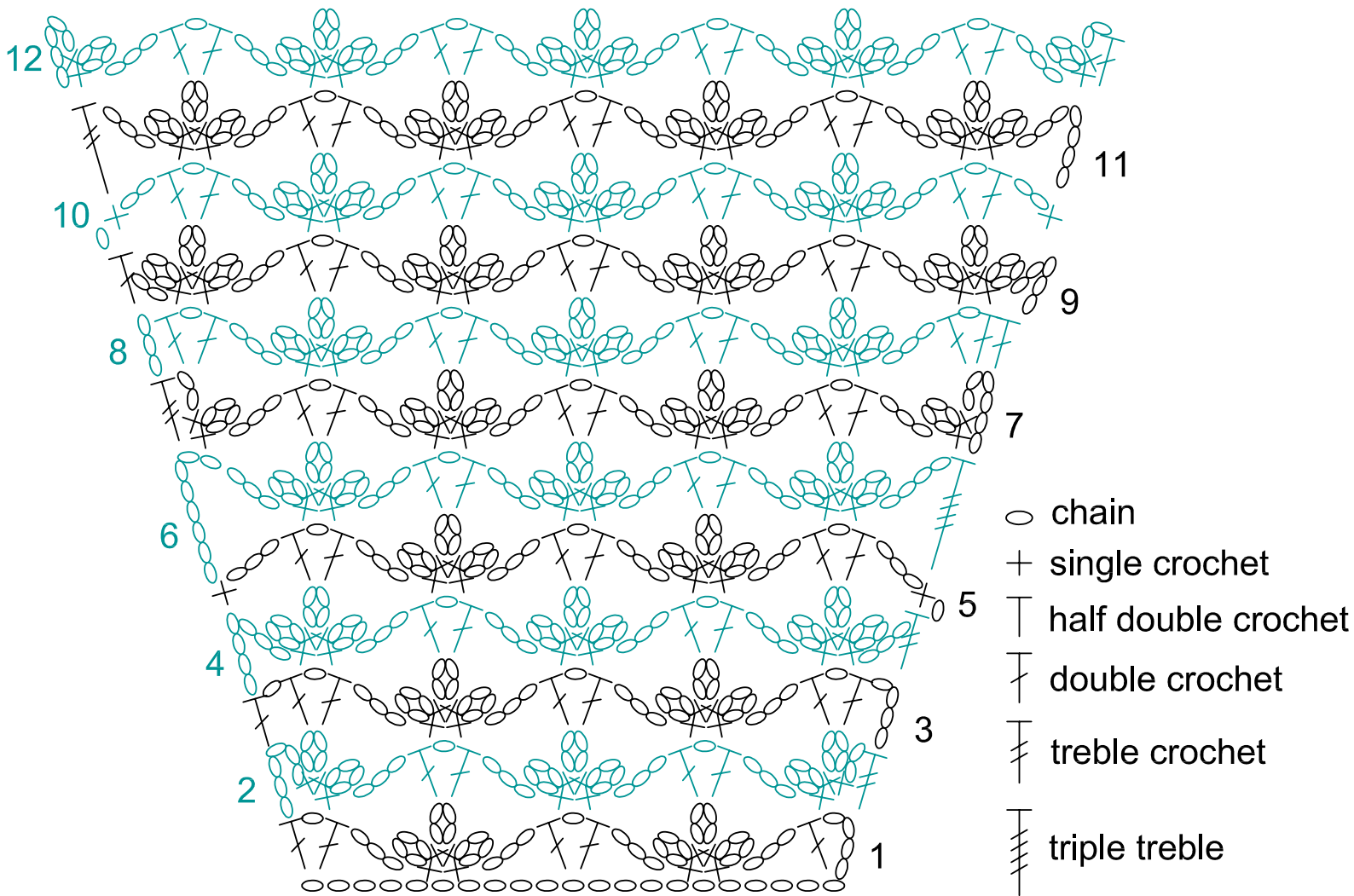
Rnd 1: Join gray to back neck of collar, ch 1, [sc in each sc to raglan seam, **sc dec** (see *Stitch Guide*) in next 2 sc at raglan seam] around, join in first sc, turn. (4 less sts)

Rnds 2–6: Ch 1, sc in each sc around with sc dec in 2 sc at raglan seam, join in first sc, turn.

Rnd 7: Sl st in each sc around. Fasten off.

Optional: If neckline is still too large for your liking, try adding an extra sc dec on each panel and each round for 8 fewer sts per rnd. ■

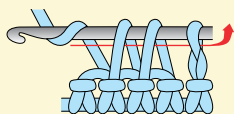

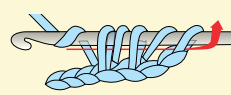

Single crochet decrease (sc dec):
(Insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



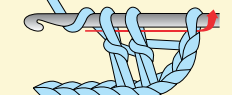
Example of 2-sc dec

Half double crochet decrease (hdc dec):
(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



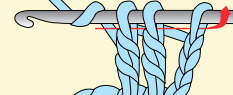
Example of 2-hdc dec

Double crochet decrease (dc dec): (Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



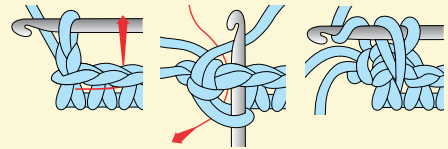
Example of 2-dc dec

Treble crochet decrease (tr dec): Holding back last lp of each st, tr in each of the sts indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

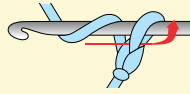


Example of 2-tr dec

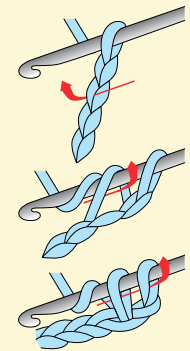
Reverse single crochet (reverse sc): Ch 1, sk first st, working from left to right, insert hook in next st from front to back, draw up lp on hook, yo and draw through both lps on hook.



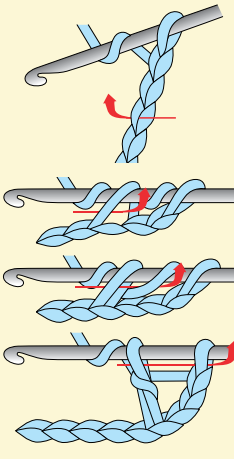
Chain (ch): Yo, pull through lp on hook.



Single crochet (sc): Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through both lps on hook.

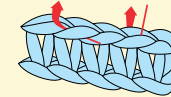


Double crochet (dc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] twice.

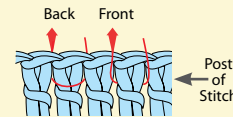


Front loop (front lp) Back loop (back lp)

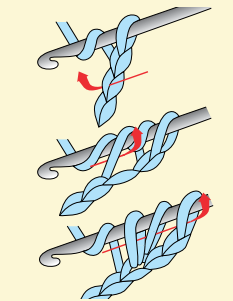
Front Loop Back Loop



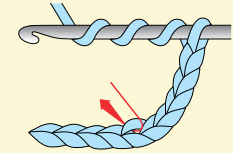
Front post stitch (fp): Back post stitch (bp): When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post of st on previous row.



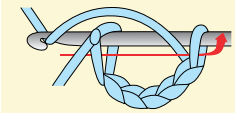
Half double crochet (hdc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.



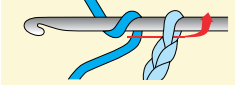
Double treble crochet (dtr): Yo 3 times, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 4 times.



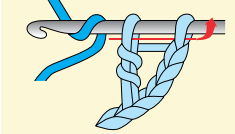
Slip stitch (sl st): Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.



Chain color change (ch color change): Yo with new color, draw through last lp on hook.



Double crochet color change (dc color change): Drop first color, yo with new color, draw through last 2 lps of st.



Treble crochet (tr): Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times.
