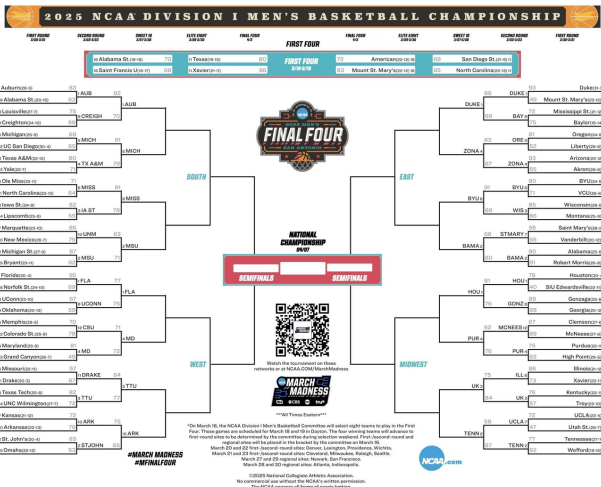

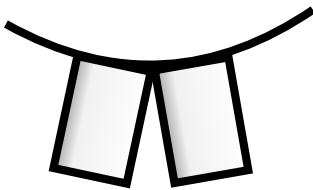
March Madness

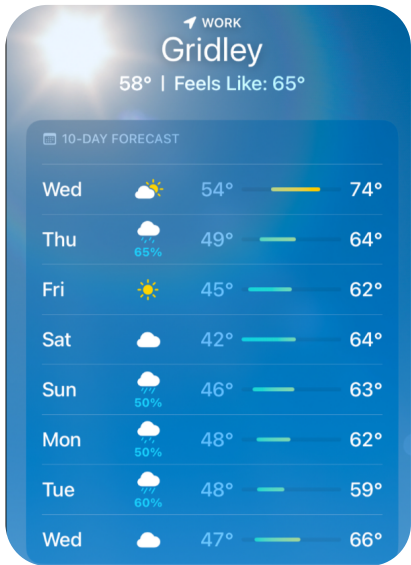




Weekly Weather Report

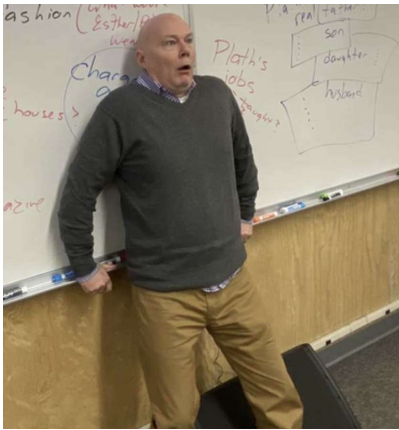
