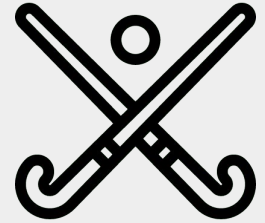

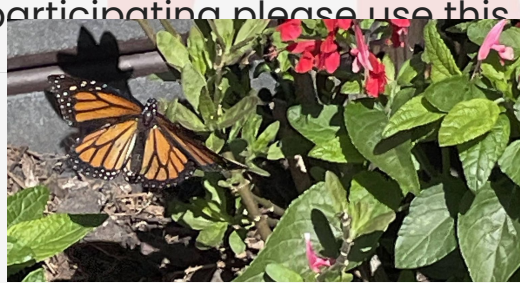
We’re here to make civics fun, competitive, and real. Learn how money and government work—while gaming, winning prizes, and outsmarting your friends.
