RESPONSIBLE

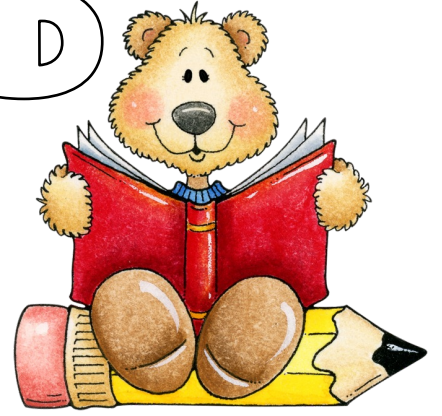
- Throw trash in the garbage can

RESPONSIBLE
