The Paskenta Nomlaki Foundation, the philanthropic arm of the Paskenta Band of Nomlaki Indians, in partnership with Rolling Hills Clinic, is proud to announce the Paskenta Tehama Medical Scholarship. This scholarship was created to support students **graduating from a Tehama County (CA) high school who are pursuing careers in the medical field**. By investing in future healthcare leaders, this scholarship aims to strengthen the local healthcare workforce and improve long-term health outcomes throughout the region.

DESCRIPTION

Two one-time scholarships of **\$10,000** each will be awarded to students who demonstrate a clear intent to pursue a career in the medical field, as well as a strong commitment to making a meaningful and lasting impact in healthcare within the regional community.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Pursuing a course of study that prepares for the medical profession
- Graduating with the Class of 2026 from a Tehama County (CA) high school
- Enrolling full-time for the 2026-27 academic year in an accredited U.S institution of higher education that participates in the federal financial aid program

In the selection process, additional consideration will be given to students who have experienced limited generational access to higher education.
