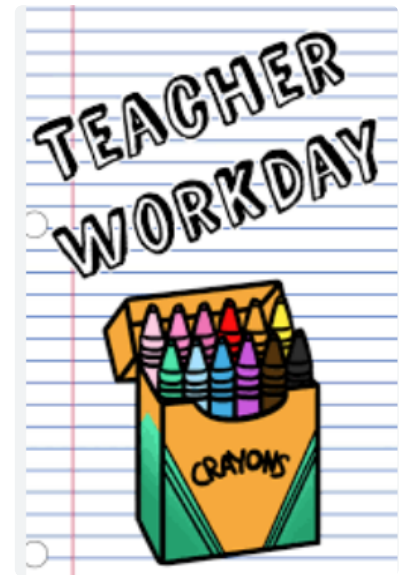
School will be closed on **Monday, January 19th** for the MLK Jr holiday



Staff Work Day

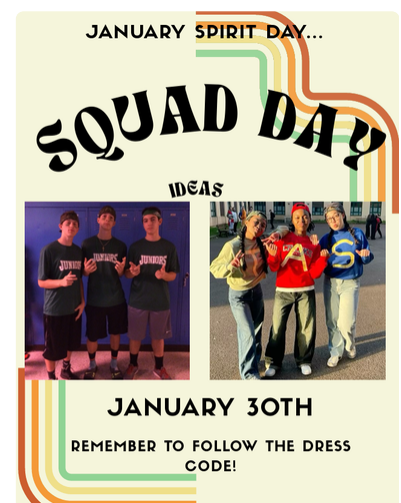
There will be a staff work day for **MIDDLE SCHOOL ONLY** on **Wednesday, January 21st**. 6th-8th grade classes will not be in session.

26/27 Cut-Off Dates

- Kindergarten: Child should be 5 years old before September 2nd (birthdate between 09/02/2020-09/01/2021)
- Transitional Kindergarten: Child should be 4 years old before September 2nd (birthdate between 09/02/2021-09/01/2022)
