Selection, Procedures, and Participant Requirements

Citizens Police Academy participants are selected through an application process. Enrollment is limited to thirty (30) students per class. Potential candidates for the Citizens Police Academy must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a minimum of 17 years of age
- Must live or work in the Chico area
- Must have **NO** felony convictions
- Must have no misdemeanor convictions within one year of application

Any of the above requirements may be waived by the Chief of Police. Classes meet Thursday evenings from 6:00pm to 9:00pm for fourteen (14) weeks at the Chico Police Department/Fire Training Center or other designated locations.
