



# Acrylic Painting: Building on the Basics

## Required Materials:

### Intermediate Class Note:

Intermediate students do not need to purchase expensive paint sets, as we will be working with a more limited color palette.

Paint is the most expensive item on this list. Students may choose any acrylic paint set; however, quality and quantity matter.

### Minimum Color Requirements

Students should have access to the following colors (listed from most to least important):

- **Titanium White**  
*Highly recommended to purchase a full tube separately, especially if using a cheaper set. This is the most frequently used color.*
- Primary colors: **Red, Yellow, Blue**
- **Magenta and Cyan** (preferred but not required)
- **Burnt Umber**
- **Yellow Ochre**
- **Ultramarine Blue**

## Brushes

- Any acrylic brush set is acceptable
- Must include a **variety of flat and round brushes**

## Painting Surface

Students should have **practice surfaces** and **at least one finished piece surface**.

### Practice Options (recommended):

- Canvas paper (pads usually include 10 sheets)
- Canvas boards (often sold in packs of 10–12)

### Final Painting Surface:

- At least **one proper canvas** (stretched canvas or canvas board)

### Size Guidelines:

- **Beginner Class:**
  - Minimum: 8 x 10
  - Maximum: 18 x 24
- **Intermediate Class:**
  - Any size is acceptable

## Palette

- Disposable **palette paper** is recommended for easy cleanup
- Physical palettes are acceptable if they are **flat** (no paint wells/divots)

## Palette Knife (Painting Knife)

- Any painting knife is acceptable
- Shape is personal preference
- If you are unsure, choose a **small palette knife**

## Sketching Supplies

- Sketchbook **or** loose paper
- **Pencil is required**
- Additional sketching tools are optional and based on personal practice
