

Cell Phone Policy 2026-2027

Pursuant to Governor Abbott's signing of House Bill 1481, school districts must have a written policy prohibiting students from using personal communication devices (including, but not limited to cell phones, smart watches, meta glasses, personal computers, air pods, wireless headphones, etc.) while on school property during the school day. If any of these devices are seen during school hours, it is a violation of policy.

Violations of this policy will be addressed accordingly:

1st offense - Communication devices will be confiscated and returned to the student at the end of the day. Parent will be contacted and a warning will be documented in Skyward.

2nd offense- Communication devices will be confiscated and students will serve one day of ISS. Communication devices will be returned to the student at the end of the day. Parent will be notified and discipline will be documented in Skyward.

3rd offense- Communication devices will be confiscated and students will serve 2 days of ISS. Communication devices will be returned to the parent, following a parent/administrator conference.

Repeated offenses may result in increased disciplinary action in accordance with the student code of conduct.
