CLASSIFICATION SPECIFICATION

DEFINITION:

Under supervision, to assist and perform semi-skilled and skilled work in a variety of trades; and to do related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Assists skilled trades persons in work projects concerned with their specialties by holding, lifting, positioning and transporting materials or equipment
- Uses hand tools to do simpler tasks
- Assists in general electrical, plumbing, and carpentry repair and maintenance work on buildings, equipment and furnishings
- May prepare surfaces, and assist in maintenance painting
- Assists in arc and gas welding, pipe fitting and concrete work
- Assists in interior and exterior plastering
- Assists in roof repair
- Operates a truck, forklift and tractor
- Uses applicable power tools and equipment in performing work related to the specialty to which assigned
- Services as substitute for personnel performing skilled tasks during their absences, and develops knowledge and skills required to qualify for higher skilled maintenance positions

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Knowledge and Abilities:

- Knowledge of common materials, tools, equipment and methods used in a building trade such as carpentry, painting, plumbing, electrical, and heating and refrigeration trades
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions
- Mechanical aptitude
- Ability to use power and hand tools related to the building trades
- Ability to lift and carry moderately heavy loads
- Ability to work cooperatively with others

Education & Experience:

Any combination equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade, and two years of experience as a maintenance person, or comparable experience in construction or maintenance work.

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Physical Requirements:

- Stand, walk, climb, bend, twist, kneel, crawl, and stoop for extended periods of time
- Lift and carry sixty (60) pounds
- Reach in all directions for extended periods of time
- Adequate sight or corrected vision for the purpose of reading laws, codes, rules, labels, district policies, and instructions

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
