1. This is primarily but not exclusively an academic scholarship.
2. To apply you must be a graduating senior at Lampasas High School.
3. An interview may be required of finalists.
4. In addition to academic achievement, emphasis is given to citizenship, service to the community, general accomplishments, and the written statement of the applicant stating why the scholarship is important to him or her.
5. This scholarship is awarded without discrimination to anyone in any manner.
6. Letters of recommendation are not required and it is suggested that such not be submitted. Instead, the applicant should present, in his or her own words, the goals and other important information about the applicant for the consideration of the trustees.
7. The scholarship is for funds up to \$1,000 per semester for four years total (8 Fall/Spring Semesters) for tuition and books at an accredited college or university of the awardee's choice. All funds are paid directly to the applicable school.
8. During the course of the four-year period applicable to the scholarship, grades and other pertinent information must be submitted to the trustees before the funds for the following semester will be paid. Course load must be a minimum of 9 hours each semester and grades must be maintained at a C or higher level in each course taken.
