HOW DOES A STUDENT EARN THEIR WAY ONTO THE LOSS OF PRIVILEGES LIST?

Any of the following bullet points may place a student on the list:

- receipt of two (2) or more disciplinary referrals to administration
- receipt of two (2) or more detentions (tardy detentions not included)
- any suspension (includes out-of-school suspension, in-school suspension, and class suspension)
- at administration's discretion

CAN A STUDENT EARN THEIR WAY OFF OF THE LOSS OF PRIVILEGE LIST?

It may be possible, however <u>ALL</u> of the following terms must be met:

- 1) Serve all assigned detentions and complete all assigned reflection activities
- 2) Complete a Personal Reflection/Persuasive Essay in which you state why you should be removed from the LOP list (see Assistant Principal for essay prompt)
- 3) at administration's discretion
