Review of NEISD Family Engagement Policy

EHBD (Legal)

- A district that receives Title I, Part A funds shall develop jointly with, agree on with, and distribute to, parents of participating children a written parent involvement policy. The policy shall be incorporated into a District plan developed under 20 U.S.C. 6312.
- Each school served under Title I, Part A shall jointly develop with, and distribute to, parents of participating children a written parental involvement policy, agreed on by such parents, that shall describe the means for carrying out the requirements of 20 U.S.C. 6318(c)– (f). Parents shall be notified of the policy in an understandable and uniform format and, to the extent practicable, provided in a language the parents can understand.


The participation of parents in regular, two-way, meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities.







- Monitoring your child's academic progress by building a relationship with your child's teachers and participate in an ongoing communication regarding decisions about student performance, instructional programs, and campus policies.
