PURPOSE:

The Yolo County Pheasants Forever Scholarship Program was established to recognize and provide a financial award to one or more outstanding graduating seniors who plan to major in and enter the **career of wildlife biology, agriculture, or a related field.**

ELIGIBILITY:

Eligibility to apply for the Yolo County Pheasants Forever Scholarship is: a graduating high school senior that plans to attend an institution of higher education and **major in wildlife biology, agriculture, or a related field.**

TYPE OF SCHOLARSHIP:

One or more scholarships will be awarded each year based on the funds available. Scholarships are nonrenewable. The awards will be based on scholastic achievement, extra-curricular activities, community service, and completion of an essay of an assigned topic. The amount will be \$500.00 per recipient.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS:

Recipients of the Yolo County Pheasants Forever Scholarship will be selected by a committee comprised of members of the Board of Directors of Yolo County Pheasants Forever. Preferential consideration will be given to applicants who are majoring in wildlife biology, agriculture, or affiliated majors.

RESPONSIBILITY OF RECIPIENTS:

Recipients must enroll as full-time students in accredited, nonprofit institutions of higher education and continue in attendance for the entire academic year without interruption, barring illness, emergency, or required military service.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS:

Recipient(s) will be notified in mid-June and contact you on the best way to award you the check.. Checks will be made payable to the school and the recipient for application to the student school expenses.
